Proposal: To Amend the Bylaws of the Home & School Association

Current Reading:

Article XI:

St. Pius X Home and School Scrip:

Section 1: St. Pius X Scrip is a Home and School fundraising project. Any profits from Scrip monies will be divided by (1) Home & School (67%), (2) St. Pius X families Tuition Credit (30%), (3) Technology (3%). These percentages may be amended by a majority vote.

Section II: St. Pius X Home & School organization will have final approval as to where money is spent.

Proposed Reading:

Article XI:

St. Pius X Home and School Scrip:

Section 1: St. Pius X Scrip is a Home and School fundraising project. Any profits from Scrip monies will be divided between Home & School and the participating families' tuition credit in percentages that are voted on by the Home and School Association. The percentages will be determined, agreed upon and published annually, with discretion allowing for promotional weeks within that timeframe.

Section II: St. Pius X Home & School Association will have final approval as to where money is spent.

- a. In recognition of the leadership role of these positions, St. Pius X Home & School will offer to the Home & School President and to the Scrip Coordinator the full profit of the participation in the Scrip Program. The benefit would coordinate with the fiscal year, running July to June, and this benefit would be retroactive to the fiscal year, July 2008-June 2009 and then continue annually.
